

BARTLOW THREE-COUNTIES CHARITY WALK

Directions

Bartlow is situated on the Camps Road, 1.5 miles south of Linton off the A1307. For the purposes of satnav, the postcode is CB21 4PW. Free parking is available on site.

Registration Terms and Conditions

1. Participants are encouraged to pre-register for the Bartlow Three Counties Charity Walk however registrations can also be taken on the day.
2. Registration for the main walks is open from 9.30 – 11.30am on Sunday 3rd May. Nature trail registration from 10am-2pm.
3. All payment by attendees will be taken on the day of the Event. No payment is required to pre-register.
4. Pre-event registration closes at midnight on Friday 1st May.
5. Minimum on-the-day sponsorship is £10 per adult and £5 per child (4-12yrs) for the 13,9 and 6 mile walks. The Nature trail is £5 for everyone but under 4's walk free. This price includes free parking. If you would like to gather additional sponsorship to support the charitable causes, a sponsorship form can be downloaded from www.bartlow.org.uk. Sponsorship to the value of £10 or more will be accepted in lieu of the entry fee.
6. Payment may be made by cash or cheque, made payable to Bartlow PCC.
7. Upon receipt of your registration form, we will send an email confirming your place. You will still need to pay and pick up walker badges and route maps at the registration tables on the day.
8. **The Bartlow Three Counties Charity Walk is a sponsored walk and participants are encouraged to raise as much sponsorship as possible in support of Addenbrooke's Palliative Care, Linton Health Centre and Bartlow Church Restoration.**
9. This Event is organized by the Bartlow Village Association, which reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to limit or deny access to any entity or individual.
10. There is no upper age limit. All children under the age of 16 years must be accompanied by an adult.
11. Please note that BVA cannot take responsibility for any person with limited mobility wishing to participate in the Bartlow Three Counties Charity Walk.
12. It is the responsibility of the participant to ensure that they are fit, well and healthy to take part in the Three Counties Charity Walk. Please consult your GP if you have any concerns over your health that may affect your ability to take part.
13. Dogs are welcome on all walks but MUST be kept on a lead at ALL times and please ensure that all dog mess must be cleared away before leaving the walk venue.
